1. The Eagle Award Application Package includes:

 - Eagle Scout Rank Application (58-728, 2000)
 - Eagle Scout Questionnaire
 - National Eagle Scout Association (NESA) application
 - Eagle Scout Rank Application Route Sheet
2. Respond to each numbered requirement *completely*.
3. Typed applications are preferred.
4. All dates are to be entered as month/day/year.
5. Double check dates, time requirements, and number of required Merit Badges between rank advancements.
6. Requirement 5 – Provide a minimum ½ page summary of project. This is in addition to the Service Project Workbook. (Typed is preferred.)
7. Requirement 6 – Provide a minimum ½ page response to all areas of requirement 6 (ambitions, life purpose, positions held, honors, awards). Requirements 5 & 6 may be combined on one page. (Typed is preferred.)
8. Take the following to your District Board of Review:
 - Eagle Scout Leadership Service Project Workbook
 - Eagle Scout Rank Application
 - Eagle Scout Questionnaire
 - Eagle Scout Rank Application Route Sheet
 - Responses to requirements 5 & 6 from Eagle Scout Rank Application
9. Take all items listed in item #8 above, a completed advancement report form, and the NESA application (optional) to the Council Service Center.

Full-Tuition Eagle Scout Scholarships At U of L

Each year, the University of Louisville provides a minimum of 10 full-tuition scholarships to Eagle Scouts. Eligibility requirements are as follows:

- Be a resident of Kentucky or the Southern Indiana counties in the Lincoln Heritage Council.
- Attain the Eagle Rank in the Lincoln Heritage Council, or any other Boy Scout Council in Kentucky by January 31.
- Have an American College Testing (ACT) composite score of 23 or higher or a comparable SAT.
- Have a high school grade point average of 3.0 or above on a 4.0 scale.

This is a ***competitive*** scholarship. For more information, contact the University of Louisville Office of Admissions at (502) 852-6531. Request a Trustees' Scholarship Application. Application deadline is January 31 each year.
